

THE JUBILEE TROPHY

This trophy, given by James Bolland and presented for the first time in 1977, will again be presented at the forthcoming Dinner.

It is awarded by nomination and ballot of members of the A5 Rangers C.C. and is for services to the club or to cycling as a whole. Voting is secret. It may be awarded to **any** class of member, whether first or second claim.

Past winners of this trophy include:

1977	Graham Cafe	For services to the Club, in particular his work in obtaining the new clubrooms.
1983	Mick Holliday	For services to cycling as a whole, in particular his work in reforming the Northampton CTC.
1988	James Bolland	For services to the Club over 40 years and in particular his work on the 40th, Annual Dinner. (This award was made by the Committee. without his knowledge)
1990	Harry Clements	For services to Club in particular his work for road racing.
1991	Ian Franklin	For services to the Club and cycling as a whole, also for his generous sponsorship and help to the Club.
1992	Maggie and Trevor Parrish	For services to the Club over many years, including the positions of General Secretary and Runs Secretary. Not forgetting the Birthday Teas and the entertainment afterwards.
1993	Sue Holliday	For services to the Club over a long period of years, including General Secretary, Treasurer, Magazine Editor, Event Organiser, etc.
1997	Duncan White	In recognition of his quiet service as Racing Secretary and Trophy Steward.
1998	Steve Cockell	For his service to the Club over many years, in particular his promotion of numerous open racing events.
1999	Janet Cafe	For her services to the Club and cycling in general as an Open events timekeeper and as Club Secretary.
2000	Trevor Parrish	For his services to the Club, in particular his organising of marshal for club events.
2002	Keith Gelder	For his services to the Club, in particular his work in the post of Club Treasurer over the last few years.
2003	Graham Cafe	For his services to the Club and cycling, particularly in measuring new courses.
2004	Mick Holliday	For his services to the Club over many years, including all aspects of cycling, particularly his work on the committee and organising events.
2006	Murray Kirton	For services to the Club, in particular his work as clothing co-ordinator.
2007	Trevor Parrish	For services to the Club, in particular his work as Social Secretary
2008	Sue Holliday	For her services to cycling in her many years on the Northampton & District C.A. committee particularly as Chairman and event organiser.
2009	Mick Holliday	For promoting Saturday Club Runs and the warm and friendly welcome given to new members, which has helped to increase the numbers of non racing members.
